Tournament Player Eligibility

To be eligible to participate in the NC State Championships, an individual must satisfy one of the following requirements at the time of registration. 1) Present a valid and current North Carolina Drivers' license (or equivalent state-provided identification). 2) Present an official league record from a North Carolina Association exhibiting participation in a minimum of three weeks of league sanctioned play in the current calendar year; or 3) Have a letter presented to the Tournament Director by the President or External Organizations officer of the player's North Carolina Association explaining that the player is current, yet non-throwing, member of that Association. Sponsorship of an Association of League does not fulfill association membership requirements for NC State Championships eligibility. No entrant into the NC State Championships may compete or have competed in the state championship events in another state in the same calendar year and violation of this rule will result in the player being banned from the tournament for 10 years.
